Current median household income is \$123,504 in the area, compared to \$72,414 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$139,270 in five years, compared to \$84,445 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$157,296 in this area, compared to \$105,029 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$178,688 in five years, compared to \$122,155 for all U.S. households

Currently, 84.5% of the 18,126 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 12.0%, renter occupied; and 3.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 17,310 housing units in the area and 3.4% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 2.07%. Median home value in the area is \$393,057, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.19% annually to \$416,956.
